This Analytic Series A-29 presents findings on substance use among workers and on workplace drug policy. NSDUH collects information on employment status, type of business, specific occupations and industries and information on drug-testing policies and programs from U.S. workers. It analyzes the worker information in conjunction with the substance use data collected in the survey to investigate substance use among full-time employed U.S. workers age 18-64 during the period 2002 to 2004. 188 pages (SAMHSA, 2007)
